Greetings open track enthusiasts! The Mustang Club of Central Iowa would like to invite you to the Mid America Motorplex (MAM) on July 24-25, 2004, for a weekend of open track excitement. Last year's event went well, Mother Nature cooperated, and we are excited to continue what should prove to be another successful event.

Due to the many requests we received over the past two years, something new has been added this year - a timed autocross on Saturday. MAM uses electronic transponders for timing and scoring. We will use these transponders to record lap times for an autocross competition. Cars will be split into classes at Tech. A practice session will be held for each run group Saturday AM. After the practice sessions are complete, group runs will commence. We will try to allow at least 4 runs for each group, probably more. If we finish the run groups early, we should have time for some more green flag touring sessions in the PM. You will compete with other cars in your class, and a dinner will be held Saturday night to hand out the awards.

Sunday will be high speed touring as in the past. Passengers will be allowed, with the appropriate helmet and seat belts. Minor passengers must have a signed parent/guardian waiver. We will divide the entrants up into run groups of similar abilities. You will be placed in a grouping to your comfort level with other drivers in that same comfort level. We will have sessions for raw beginners up to the pros, so be assured you can come and enjoy touring the track with drivers of similar skills. This is an opportunity for you to drive your car at speed, in a safe, controlled environment. This is not a competitive event. Safety is our paramount concern.

Please take note of the new pricing structure. There is a significant savings for registering before the June 21st early registration deadline, and an even greater savings to attend both days.

The Mid America Motorplex is conveniently located along Interstate 29 at the Glenwood exit, approximately 15 miles south of Interstate 80 near the Omaha/Council Bluffs metro area. The Omaha area has many attractions to offer, including the Henry Doorly Zoo, Rainforest, Aquarium and IMAX theatre, Strategic Air Command Museum, the Omaha Royals baseball team, Bluffs Run greyhound track and casino, Harvey's Casino, Ameristar Casino, the Old Market shopping and dining district, and many others. General Rules

All cars must pass tech inspection. Tech will be available at the track on Friday, July 23rd, from 4-6 PM. Tech will also be available at the track on Saturday, July 24th from 6:30 AM- 9:00 AM, and on Sunday July 25th from 6:30 AM- 9:00 AM. In addition, early pre-event tech will be held at Dewey Ford in Ankeny, Iowa, at 7:00 PM on Wednesday, July 21st. Contact Doug Hammond at 515-288-1308 or dshammond@earthlink.com to sign up for early tech. If you can make one of the early tech sessions, it will help to reduce the long lines at the track.

When you arrive at tech, you and your car should be in ready-to-run condition. You are responsible for the condition of your car. Fill out the tech form beforehand and check off each area as you inspect it. Remove all loose items from the trunk, passenger compartment, etc. Bring the helmet you will run. The helmet must meet Snell M90, M95, M2000, SA90, SA95, or SA2000 specs. There WILL NOT be helmets to borrow. You must bring your own. Tech inspection will include, but is not limited to, the following items: Battery hold down, throttle return spring(s), suspension wear and play, brakes, tires, fluids, radiator catch can, seatbelts, helmet, and no loose articles in car. Any in-car cameras/video cameras must be securely mounted. No hand held in-car cameras will be allowed. Roll bars are required for convertibles. No open-wheel cars or motorcycles allowed. Exact tech requirements will be mailed to you with your confirmation packet upon receipt of your registration.

Driver meetings are mandatory. Miss it, and you will not run that day. Each driver will receive a wristband indicating that they have been to the drivers meeting. No driver will be allowed onto the track without the appropriate wristband.

This is not a racing event. Please note that any damage done to the facility, any of its parts, to other drivers or their cars and property, is your responsibility. Let's be careful out there. You are financially responsible for any damage you may cause.

Registration is per driver. Multiple drivers per car will be assigned to separate run groups, and each must pay the registration fees. Drivers must be at least 18 years old and have a valid driver's license.

Car numbers will be assigned on a first-come, first-served basis upon receipt of payment. Payment must accompany registration to reserve your number and spot. Just sending in the registration form does not guarantee you a spot or a number. Numbers must be at least 8 inches high, and must be visible on each side of your car by corner workers. "Taped" numbers are acceptable. If your three choices are already taken, you will be contacted to select another.

Early Registration Deadline is June 21st, 2004. We must have received payment from you by this date or the late registration fee will be assessed. Registration is limited. This event is expected to sell out, so register early to ensure you have a spot. The event will be held rain or shine. We have already rented the track, so we must use it.

No refunds will be issued after June 21st, 2004. It will be up to you to sell your spot. Refund requests received in writing, on or before the June 21st early registration deadline, will be honored and charged a \$20.00 fee to cover administrative costs.

When we receive your registration form and payment, we will send you a detailed confirmation packet, along with a car number and hotel info. Room reservations must be made directly with the hotels. If you have any questions, please contact one of the following people:
